ASH WEDNESDAY

February 26 is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Lenten season. Lent is a 40 day period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving which lasts from Ash Wednesday to Holy Saturday but it doesn't include Sundays! Next to Christmas and Easter, it is the third busiest day of the year at St Peter and many Catholic Churches. Although it is not a Holy Day of Obligation, everyone is encouraged to attend Mass on this day in order to focus on repentance and turning towards God. Ashes are a symbol of mourning and penance and the biblical custom was to fast, wear sackcloth, sit in dust and ashes and put dust and ashes on your head. Attending Mass, praying, fasting and abstaining from meat doesn't sound too bad in comparison!

Don't forget to pick up a little black book to give you a daily inspirational boost. Remember that every prayer, sacrifice, Mass, devotion and offering we make helps us on our journey of faith. We hope that you will join us this Lenten sea-son at daily Mass (8:00am and 5:30pm M-F), Stations of the Cross (Fridays at 3:00pm and 7:00pm), Sacrament of Penance or Confession (Sat. 3:00pm-4:00pm) and Adoration on Fridays.
