## St Blaise

Saturday, February 3 is the Feast day of St Blaise of Sebaste. Many Catholics remember this feast day as the day they have their throats blessed.

It is believed that St Blaise was born in the fourth century to a wealthy family in Armenia (now part of Turkey) who raised him as a Christian. He became a physician and then a Bishop of the area. He was persecuted and received a message from God to go into the hills to escape. While there, he cured many wild animals that were ill. Legend says that after he was captured, he cured a young boy who was choking on a fish bone. St Blaise was beaten and beheaded for his refusal to renounce his faith and love of God. He is known as the patron saint of wild animals and throat maladies.

On February 3, there will be a blessing of the throats after the 8:00am and 5:30pm Daily Masses. Two blessed candles are held slightly open, and pressed against the throat as the **blessing** is said. "May Almighty God at the intercession of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, preserve you from infections of the throat and from all other afflictions".

**Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptisms are celebrated in English each Saturday of each month following the 4:30pm Mass. Parents are required to be registered members of St. Peter and must attend a Baptismal Preparation Program. You are encouraged to attend the program before your baby is born. The upcoming English programs are Feb 8, & Mar 14 beginning promptly at 9:00am. Please register in advance.

**Sacrament of Marriage:** Marriages are celebrated on Saturdays at 11:00am and 2:00pm. Registered engaged couples should contact the Parish Office a minimum of 4 months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparations.

**Sacrament of Reconciliation:** Saturday from 3:15pm-4:00pm or by appointment

**Adoration and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament:** On First Friday of each month, Adoration begins after the 8:00am Mass and concludes with a Benediction service at 7:00pm. All other Fridays during the month have Adoration until 10:00pm.

**Divine Mercy Devotions:** The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be recited Tuesday-Friday at 7:45am.

**Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion:** Active members of this ministry are required to attend a refresher training at least once a year. Please contact Leonardo Busa in the parish office if you are interested in joining this ministry.

**Godparents/Sponsors:** Must be Catholics who have been baptized and **confirmed** and they should be at least 16 years old. They should be practicing Catholics, going to Mass on Sundays and receiving Communion regularly. If married, they must be married in the Catholic Church. Godparents need a "Sponsor Certificate" from the parish where they are registered indicating that they are qualified to serve as godparents/sponsors.

**Homebound or Critically Ill:** If you are homebound and wish to receive the Eucharist please call Deacon Stephen Scienzo in the Parish Office.

**Hospital Visitation:** If you would like to receive Holy Communion while you are in the hospital, please register at the hospital as a Catholic.

**Lectors:** If you are interested in becoming a lector, please contact Leonardo Busa in the parish office.

**Perpetual Novena of Our Lady:** To Mary, The Immaculate Conception, Mondays before 8:00am Mass.

**Registration:** Seasonal Parishioners and permanent residents are requested to register in the Parish as soon as possible after moving into the Parish. Registration forms are available on our parish website and in the office.

**Rosary Group:** The Rosary is prayed Monday-Friday after the 8:00am Daily Mass.

**All Saints School Parents:** In order to qualify for the Catholic Tuition Rate discount offered to you as a parishioner, the following requirements must be met: 1. Be an active, practicing member of the parish - attending Mass on a regular basis with your family. 2. Be at the Stewardship Level of Offering. 


