

LOAVES AND FISHES Bambinelli Sunday

Bambinelli Sunday is a beautiful tradition started by Pope St John Paul II more than thirty years ago. Each year on the Third Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete or Rose Sunday, children gather with their families in St. Peter's Square in Rome. The children bring their baby Jesus figures from their family's Nativity set. During the noontime Angelus prayer, the pope blesses the children and the figurines they have brought. "Bambinelli" (which is plural for bambinello) is little baby boy in Italian.

The book <u>Bambinelli Sunday: A Christmas Blessing</u> by Amy Welborn tells the story of a little boy, Alessandro, and what he learns about family, faith and love.

Parishes in the United States are starting to follow this lovely tradition. At St Peter, we began this custom in 2015 We invite everyone to bring their baby Jesus figures to Mass the weekend of Dec 14 & 15. for a special blessing at the end of Mass.




Sacrament of Reconciliation: Saturday from 3:15pm-4:00pm or by appointment






