

Diocesan Retired Priests **Ash Wednesday**

The second collection today is for the Retired Diocesan Priests. This is the fifth year of this collection. In the past, when a priest retired, his health and car insurance were paid by the last parish where he was assigned. This policy didn't really make sense since some parishes were paying for two priests and some were not paying for any (such as St Peter). In order to make this more equitable, the Diocese has implemented a plan where every parish will be taxed 1% of their offertory collection to be placed in a fund to pay for these expenses. Our total bill from the Diocese for 2019 was \$16,311.12. After subtracting what we received in the second collection in February 2019 (\$5,086), we submitted a check for the balance, \$11,225.12. We estimate the bill for 2020 will be around 16,800. This assessment will be reduced by the amount of the second collection given today.

This collection is not to be confused with the Diocesan collection taken up in December for the Retired Religious. That collection is a national appeal (initiated by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) to assist religious priests (not diocesan) and sisters with their retirement expenses.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated in English each Saturday of each month following the 4:30pm Mass. Parents are required to be registered members of St. Peter and must attend a Baptismal Preparation Program. You are encouraged to attend the program before your baby is born. The upcoming English programs are Feb 8, & Mar 14 beginning promptly at 9:00am. Please register in advance.

Sacrament of Marriage: Marriages are celebrated on Saturdays at 11:00am and 2:00pm. Registered engaged couples should contact the Parish Office a minimum of 4 months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparations.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Saturday from 3:15pm-4:00pm or by appointment

Adoration and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament: On First Friday of each month, Adoration begins after the 8:00am Mass and concludes with a Benediction service at 7:00pm. All other Fridays during the month have Adoration until 10:00pm.

Divine Mercy Devotions: The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be recited Tuesday-Friday at 7:45am.

Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion: Active members of this ministry are required to attend a refresher training at least once a year. Please contact Leonardo Busa in the parish office if you are interested in joining this ministry.

Godparents/Sponsors: Must be Catholics who have been baptized and **confirmed** and they should be at least 16 years old. They should be practicing Catholics, going to Mass on Sundays and receiving Communion regularly. If married, they must be married in the Catholic Church. Godparents need a "Sponsor Certificate" from the parish where they are registered indicating that they are qualified to serve as godparents/sponsors.

Homebound or Critically Ill: If you are homebound and wish to receive the Eucharist please call Deacon Stephen Scienzo in the Parish Office.

Hospital Visitation: If you would like to receive Holy Communion while you are in the hospital, please register at the hospital as a Catholic.

Lectors: If you are interested in becoming a lector, please contact Leonardo Busa in the parish office.

Perpetual Novena of Our Lady: To Mary, The Immaculate Conception, Mondays before 8:00am Mass.

Registration: Seasonal Parishioners and permanent residents are requested to register in the Parish as soon as possible after moving into the Parish. Registration forms are available on our parish website and in the office.

Rosary Group: The Rosary is prayed Monday-Friday after the 8:00am Daily Mass.

All Saints School Parents: In order to qualify for the Catholic Tuition Rate discount offered to you as a parishioner, the following requirements must be met: 1. Be an active, practicing member of the parish - attending Mass on a regular basis with your family. 2. Be at the Stewardship Level of Offering. 
